The Pearson BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) is at level 4 (the same as the first year of a UK honours degree).

HND

The Pearson BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) is at level 4 and level 5 (the same as the first two years of a UK honours degree).

FEATURES:

- This programme is designed to be a two year HND level 5 course which is equivalent to the first two years of a Degree Programme.
- On completion of the first year (at HNC level
 4) accreditation can be claimed.
- No formal examination. Course work is mainly project-based and learners are encouraged to experiment with a wide variety of materials and techniques.
- Studying in our specially equipped fashion and textile classrooms, you will work on projects from the initial planning and research stages, through design and development, to the production of final outcome.
- Top-up your HND in fashion and textile to full Honours degree by spending just one more year.
